## .10 Traffic Stop Data Collection

A. The agency will comply with the requirements of TR 25-113 starting January 1, 2003.

B. Agency officers will collect and submit, in the format adopted by this agency, required information for all traffic stops consistent with TR 25-113.

## .20 Procedures for Traffic Stop Data Collection

- A. The following procedures will take place for the collection of traffic stop data:
  - 1. Officers will complete one scantron sheet for each traffic stop initiated.
  - 2. Scantron sheets can be completed in pen or pencil. Pencils and erasers will be kept in each vehicle for officer use in filling out forms.
  - 3. If, when filling out a form, an error is made, the form can be thrown away and a new form may be completed.
  - 4. Scantron sheets are not required for radar stops.
  - 5. The completed scantron sheets will be submitted to Records with the appropriate traffic stop paperwork, if applicable, in accordance with (check numbered policy for submitting citations).
