2.454 STOP & FRISK

- A. Officers are permitted to stop and frisk individuals consistent with:
 - 1. CR 4-206; and
 - 2. Directives contained in 1.110.04 Stop & Frisk and 2.428 Investigative Detentions / Field Interviews.
- B. Officers who stop and frisk individuals will:
 - 1. Do so consistent with statutes, case law, training, and directives; and
 - 2. Complete MIRs detailing the circumstances, reasons, and results of stops and frisks.
 - 3. Complete Firearm Report (MSP 97) items 1 16, excepting item 10, and submit same to the Records Unit before the end of their tours of duty. MSP 97s must be completed regardless of whether or not weapons are discovered.
- C. Maryland Safety Equipment Repair Order / Warning (MSP 157) will not be used by officers in lieu of MSP 97s when they stop and frisk individuals.
- D. Records Unit personnel are responsible for:
 - 1. Printing copies of completed stop and frisk related incident reports;
 - 2. Attaching related report copies to MSP 97s and mailing same to the MSP Licensing Division; and
 - 3. Retaining copies of MSP 97s in agency files.
